SR. MARILOU'S OCTOBER 2011 PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

This November will be the first year for school districts to administer the Iowa Assessments, formerly called Iowa Test of Basic Skills. The ITBS were revised to better reflect the Iowa Core (key concepts and skills plus 21st century literacy for finances, employability, technology, civics and health) in grades 3-8. St. Patrick students will take Iowa Assessments November 1 to November 9 with November 10 and 11 as make up dates.

Alice Conlon will be here on Oct. 5 at 1:30 pm to conduct my principals evaluation with the teachers and support staff.

Our new five year Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP) was submitted to the DE in mid September. Increasing math problem solving and computation strategies are two areas teachers will focus on these next three to five years. The fourth Wednesday of each month's faculty meeting time is dedicated to increasing teacher math strategies and resources (learning centers). Sue O'Connell's presentation, Dec. 9, is another aspect of this year's math professional development plan. Sue will work with K-4 teachers that morning and Gr. 5-8 teacher in the afternoon. I have invited the NW and Central principals groups to send two or more teachers to this professional development opportunity. Sue, a national math consultant, author and founder of Quality Teacher Development, travels the nation giving math teachers new strategies, ideas and resources to increase student learning. Sue was suggested by our professional development committee. I'm using Title II Part A and our local professional development dollars to pay her.
