Thanks to our teachers, parents and waiter Jonathan Shepard, the marketing/recruitment committee raised \$810 in tips and about \$350 from Pizza Ranch (7% of total take for the 5-8 pm hours). This \$1160 was earmarked for the newly hired PR Director, Donna Bash, who begins her eight month (Sept. - April) ten hours a week job.
