**1. Opening Prayer**

**2. Art Show thoughts - Joni Krejchi**

- a.** The art show covers non-athletic people and highlights our artists! Joni is looking for helpers this week (Thursday, May 12 - 3:30-??) to learn the ropes and for people to be involved for next year's art show. Joni is willing to coordinate the "in-house" art work, but is looking for people to coordinate decorations, food, musicians, PR, matting and framing of art, etc.
- b.** Art Show was added to the volunteer form for next year and four people have already signed up.

**3. Charger Apparel - Lori Nurse**

- a.** Roll into Fundraising Committee??
  - i.** This was discussed and decided to move under the fundraising umbrella but maintain it's own chair.
  - ii.** Lori is willing to continue on one more year but would like to have a co-chair willing to take over in 2012-2013
  - iii.** This year the order form was sent out once. Other years they have tried more than one order but did not have a large order the second time. Orders forms coming in September/October works best. To stir up more orders it was discussed to display the apparel for help with sizing. Also, a "Charger Day" at school where apparel can be worn. Once a month or for the first home game of every sport season. The idea was brought up to pursue other avenues for apparel. Eastbay was suggested to look into. **4. 2011/12 Board Members and Committees**

- a.** President/Vice President
  - i.** Lisa Wageman was elected President
  - ii.** Michelle Heine was elected Vice President with the understanding she will become President for the 2012-2013 school year.
  - iii.** Lanette Tynan was elected Secretary
  - iv.** Michelle Purdy reported the following committees still need chairs
    - 1.** Health Screening (Sister Marilou will ask Marie Stigliani, school nurse, to do this)
    - 2.** Conference Dinners
    - 3.** Bulletin Board (Lisa Wageman will call the four mom's currently doing this)
    - 4.** Fundraising
      - a.** This committee format will be changing. Katie Anderson will chair the Trivia Night, Michelle Heine will chair the Shamrock Shuffle, we're

looking for someone to coordinate the smaller fundraisers (i.e. Chuck E. Cheese night).

**5. Financial Report**

- a. \$3,000 still needed for teacher checks
  - i. It was moved and seconded that \$3,000 be set aside for teachers in the fall
- b. The additional \$2,100 will be kept in the CPTO account for next year

**6. Teacher Thoughts - Lisa Newgard**

- a. Major items for next year (Nooks??)
  - i. No decision was made for fundraising monies for next year. This will be revisited in the fall
  - ii. Unit D request for next year
    - 1. Units C & D are requesting \$350 for an African Dance experience which extends the learning from a Gallagher-Bluedorn performance. The experience lasts 5 consecutive days and is for 4 classrooms. This request was approved.
  - iii. Lisa thanked CPTO for all their fundraising work this year to fund 10 student laptops. Those laptops have allowed 1300 additional hours of usage by students this year over last. Teachers are satisfied with the laptops available to them now.

**7. Fundraising - Michelle Heine**

- i. Shamrock Shuffle is still waiting for some sponsorship checks. Overall, the Shuffle raised \$4500. There is a lot of water leftover that is being used in many different areas of the school. The tentative date for next year is April 14.
  - 1. Next year Shamrock Shuffle volunteer committee will utilize Kohl's volunteers and the \$500 will go to the Marketing committee.

**8. Volunteers - Michelle Purdy**

- a. Volunteer form was revised for the change in the Fundraising Committee and updated committee chairs.
- b. The form will be sent out again with a reminder that people who signed up at the Art Show do not need to fill it out again.
- c. Art Show worked well to get committees filled

**9. 120th Anniversary**

- a. Creating an Ad Hoc committee to work on this project. The Marketing/ Recruitment committee has started a conversation but a committee is needed. An email will go out to parents soon looking for volunteers. The first order of business will be for the Sturgis Falls Parade. We will have Al McAlpin drive his John Deere truck with as many former Principals of the school we can have along with Sister Marilou. Students will walk behind with signs promoting our school, especially SIE groups. There are other ideas in the works like a Sock Hop in November and inviting the Archbishop to celebrate Mass.
