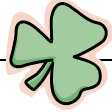


Why choose St. Patrick School when our community is known for having a quality public school system?

♣ Small Class Size

- ◆ 2009 -2010 class sizes range from 13 -18.
- ◆ The kindergarten classrooms currently have 13 and 15 students. The kindergarten classes are each staffed with a full-time teacher and a half-time associate.

♣ Academic Excellence

- ◆ On the 2008 ITBS, the average scores of St. Patrick students were: 96% for reading/comprehension, 97% for math and 96% for Science.
- ◆ Spanish language instruction K – 8.
- ◆ Public speaking instruction K – 8. Even our kindergarteners are so confident they speak in front of the entire school with ease!

♣ Technology, Technology, Technology!

- ◆ St. Patrick has a full-time, dedicated Technology Instructor.
- ◆ In addition to having a computer lab, we have laptops in the classrooms, K-8.
- ◆ Technology is integrated into the curriculum at all grade levels. Students routinely create electronic presentations, iMovie and podcast documentaries, graphs using spreadsheets and more. Even our kindergarteners take digital photos, use computers independently, and explore websites to enhance classroom learning.
- ◆ Document cameras in classrooms project printed pages, maps, 3-D objects, even microscopes slides, allowing more dynamic and interactive classroom discussions.

- ◆ Extracurricular Activities: science club, book club, art club, Math Counts.
- ◆ Athletic programs begin in 5th grade.
